SASME CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

SASME is an Arizona Non-Profit Corporation. As such, SASME has a Constitution and Bylaws. These are available from SASME's website. In the Constitution, SASME is referred to as "the Society". The State requires a simple annual form to be submitted. Robin Preiser does this job as "Statutory Agent".

The Constitution states the name and purpose of the Society, as well as duties of the Board of Directors and Officers, how officers and board members are elected, frequency of meetings, how to amend the Constitution, rules for the Bylaws, and how dissolution of the Corporation is to be handled.

The purpose of the Society is: 1) to increase the satisfaction of members in the hobby, 2) increase social interaction of the members through group activities, and 3) increase the model-

ing abilities of members through education programs such as clinics and informational discussions.

Having a layout helps with all three of these purposes but is not a requirement of the Society. The layout increases interaction among members, allows increased satisfaction in the hobby, and provides the opportunity to learn more about railroading and modeling.

The Society's Bylaws define the application and approval process for membership, fees and dues, membership responsibilities and types, and various appointed positions within the Society.
